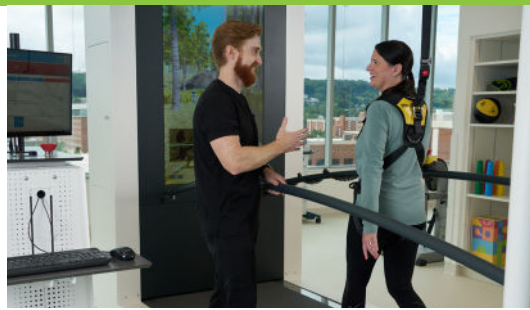

Spain Rehabilitation Center has a new home in the UAB Rehabilitation Pavilion. Patients and families have access to a wide range of features and support services, including:

- 78 inpatient rehab beds
- Access to acute care seizure monitoring and hospitalist medical units
- Therapy gyms on each patient floor
- Private therapy rooms and speech therapy suites
- Patient lifts in each room, for safer transfers and moving to and from the shower
- A multisensory room, to reduce anxiety and agitation in patients with brain injuries
- An automobile simulator, to help prepare patients for car transfers
- Family laundry and kitchen areas on each patient floor
- Outdoor terrain park and simulated city streetscape to practice mobility on various surfaces, curbs, crosswalks, and ramps
- Recreational spaces, including a putting green and basketball court
- Family respite area and patient art gallery on the 11th floor
- Rooftop garden, to promote mobility, range of motion, and emotional well-being
- Outdoor rooftop terrace, with access to an indoor activity room
- Floor-to-ceiling windows in much of the facility, allowing for plenty of natural light and great views of the Birmingham cityscape
- Artwork with Alabama and Birmingham themes throughout the building
- Neurorehabilitation care, for patients recovering from stroke, brain injury, spinal cord injury, and related conditions
- Every hallway, therapy space, and outdoor area was designed with hope and healing in mind.
